

Christine Nöstlinger was born in Vienna in 1936. Since 1970 she has published more than one hundred children's and young adult's books. Most of them have been translated into many languages and have become Classics. She has received many literary awards such as the Deutscher Jugendliteraturpreis (1973), the Hans Christian Andersen Award (1984) and the Astrid Lindgren Memorial Award (2003). Christine Nöstlinger lives in Vienna, in a farm in Lower Austria.

**Katharina Sieg** was born in 1982 in Lippstadt. She studied illustration in Hamburg, where she still lives and works as a freelance illustrator.

Every morning at 10 a.m. the dog Max leaves the ferry, walks through the little town on the island and finally lies down in the shadow of the church. But what is he looking for? He tells a different story to everyone who asks: he's escaping from an amorous cat, he waits for his lost father or he tries to catch a thief who has stolen his burse. When the girl Lina wants to know why he is lying, Max is disgusted. He does not lie, he is just telling stories!

The great storyteller Christine Nöstlinger has written a charming picture book about storytelling; exciting, funny and at the same time with touching earnestness.

Christine Nöstlinger studied in Vienna before she started to write. Since 1970 she published more than a hundred children's and young adult's books. 



His imaginatively narrated and illustrated books are characterized by their warmth, and have entered the canon of German children's literature. In 2013 he was awarded the Golden Decoration of Merit from the state of Vienna.












# Ulrike Motschiunig III. by Florence Dailleux Dream, Little Fox!

Vienna was her chosen home, where she died in 1995. She wrote over 100 children's books which were translated into many languages and awarded many times.

Angelika Kaufmann studied in Vienna and in Krakow. She made several exhibitions in Germany and other countries. She is now living in Vienna and in Warnungs.

Dad says these are Vins feelings. But Vin cannot believe he has feelings, because he has never seen any of them!










# Thomas Brezina III. by Petra Herberger Pippa and the Coloured Paws – New Series



Stefan Karch is an author, an illustrator and a puppeteer. With his self-made puppets he brings life into the phantasies of his books.



## Christoph Mauz Motte Maroni (Vol. 3) Attack of the Allotment-Zombies






